COMMITMENT TO RISE PROGRAM

To maintain your status in the Project RISE program you will need to fully participate in one year of paid research and career development training in language and literacy beginning June 1st and finishing May 31st. During this time period, your commitment will include:

- an 8-week summer academy
- a 2-week winter institute (January)
- 7 hours per week research internship during the Fall and Spring semesters
- and 4 hours once per month Saturday Connections session during the Fall and Spring semesters
