Jacki Mac is the recipient of the William Simonds King Memorial Scholarship from the College of Education.

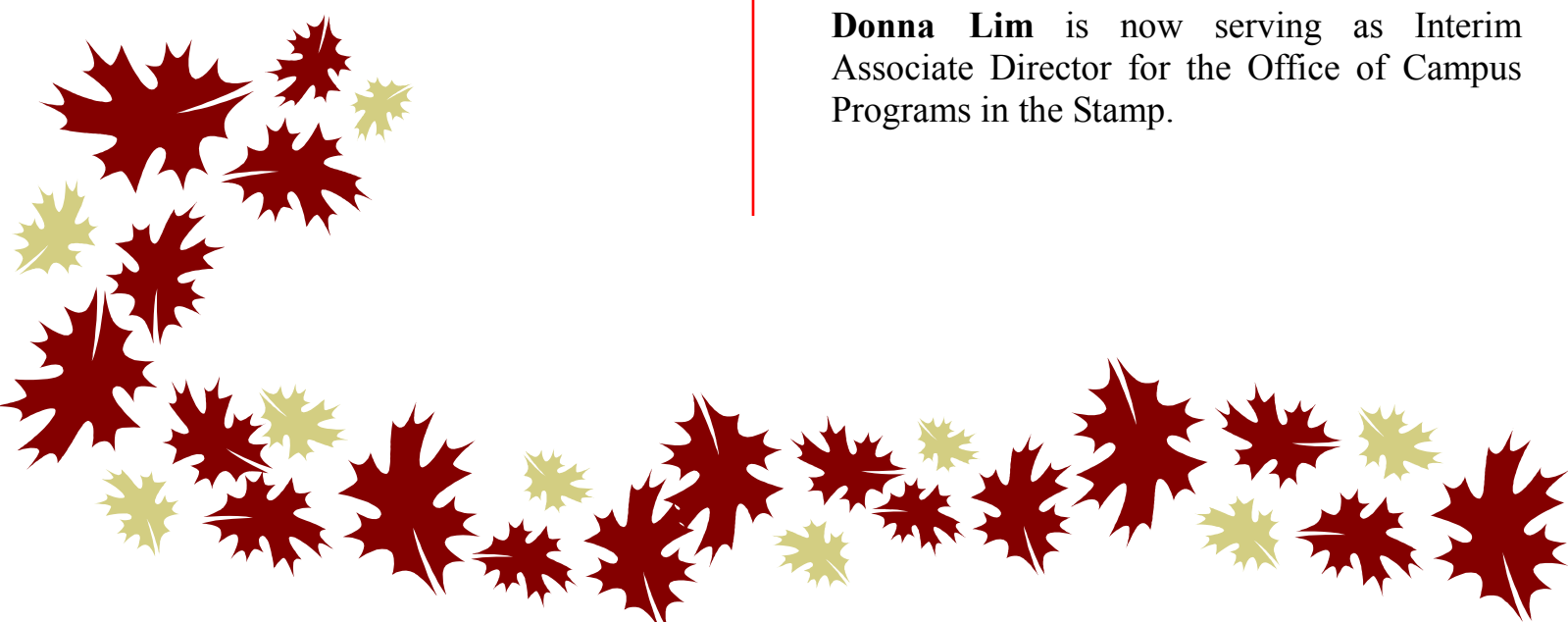
