The Ed.D. in School System
Leadership focuses on providing
senior central office personnel and
principals within the county with
advanced leadership competencies
in the areas of: teaching and learning, assessment and accountability, community interactions, and
managing and enhancing human
and fiscal resources. The goal of
the program is to produce education leaders who can support innovative, creative, knowledge-based
practices that lead to successful
school systems.

The curriculum is organized around six core topical seminars. There are four additional courses related to research, evaluation, and assessment methodologies. Dissertation research is embedded into all courses.

A variety of delivery methods are used to meet the needs of participants, including: intensive summer sessions, online modules, virtual classroom, weekend sessions, and traditional methods.
